INTRODUCTION:

- 1. There is much discussion about angels today.

 2. It has become a new fad.
- 3. The New Age Movement has developed a religion around them.
- 4. They teach that angels are sent to help us to new enlightenment. Regardless of our beliefs or which god we serve, they will assist us.
- 5. New Age teaches that angels appear in subtle ways: newspaper headlines, songs, words of others, visualization, thoughts, words of children, meditation, dreams, chants, etc.
- 6. New Age teaches angels can make sure our prayers get through, and they encourage us to pray directly to angels.
- 7. We are taught that we can make contact through channeling and spiritualists.
- 8. But what does the Bible say?

I. WHAT ARE ANGELS?

THE BIBLE SAYS: HEB 1:14 PSA 103:20 LK 1:13

FROM THIS WE LEARN:

- 1. Angels are ministering spirits sent by God. Heb 1:14
- 2. Angels are sent by God to accomplish His will. Psa 103:20
- 3. The word angel means messenger, and the messages always relate to God's plan for His people. Lk 1:13

II. DOES EVERYONE HAVE A GUARDIAN ANGEL?

THE BIBLE SAYS: HEB 1:14 PSA 91:1-2,11-12

FROM THIS WE LEARN:

- 1. Angels are sent to minister to those who are saved. Heb 1:14
- 2. Angels are sent to keep us in all of our ways—if we trust in God & dwell in God. Ps 91:1-2, 11-12

III. HOW DO ANGELS COME TO US?

THE BIBLE SAYS: LK 2:9 HEB 13:2 ACTS 1:11 HEB 1:14

FROM THIS WE LEARN:

- 1. Angels can appear as glorious creatures. Lk 2:9
- 2. Angels can appear as human beings. Heb 13:2
- 3. Angels can speak audibly. Acts 1:11
- 4. Angels usually prefer to remain unseen, unheard behind the scenes as ministering spirits. Heb 1:14

IV. CAN WE MAKE CONTACT WITH ANGELS?

THE BIBLE SAYS: DEUT 18:10-12 GEN 19:1 ROM 1:21,25,28; 8:7

JOS 1:8 MATT 6:9 I TIM 2:5 PSA 65:2 ROM 8:26-27

FROM THIS WE LEARN:

- 1. We are not to seek contact with spirits or mediums. Deut 18:10-12
- 2. Angels are sent to contact us when directed by God. Gen 19:1
- 3. Imagery and visualization in the mind are distorted because of the sin of the flesh and cannot be trusted. Rom 1:21, 25, 28; 8:7
- 4. Meditations are to be acceptable to God, be Bible centered, and focused on God—not on angels. Jos 1:8
- 5. Our prayers are to be to God—not to or through angels. Matt 6:9 I Tim 2:5 Psa 65:2 God does not need angels to be sure our prayers get through.
- 6. The Holy Spirit assists our prayers. Rom 8:26-27
