## I. WHAT IS A FUNDAMENTALIST?

**THE BIBLE SAYS:** DEUT 4:2 JER 6:16

### FROM THIS WE LEARN:

1. A Christian must comply with Deut 4:2 to be a Fundamentalist. Deut 4:2
2. Rejection of Fundamentalism is not new. Jer 6:16

## II. IS IT POSSIBLE TO OVER EMPHASIZE GOD'S WORD INSTEAD OF GOD'S NAME?

**THE BIBLE SAYS:** PS 138:2 I THESS 2:13 PSA 68:11; 119:30 I TIM 6:3-5

### FROM THIS WE LEARN: FUNDAMENTALIST:

1. Believe it is impossible to over emphasize the importance of the Bible. Ps 138:2
2. Believe the God's Word works in believers to make them more like God. I Thess 2:13
3. Fundamentalists will not promote any other Bible than the one given by the Lord. Ps 68:11
4. Fundamentalists will withdraw from those who reject the Word of God. I Tim 6:3-5

## III. WHAT DO FUNDAMENTALISTS BELIEVE ABOUT:

### A. CREATION AND EVOLUTION?

**THE BIBLE SAYS:** COL 1:16 GEN 1:3-26; 1:31

### FROM THIS WE LEARN:

1. God created all things by speaking them into existence. Col 1:16  
Gen 1: 3, 6, 9, 11, 14, 20, 24, 26
2. God was pleased with what He had made. Gen 1:31

### B. JESUS CHRIST?

**THE BIBLE SAYS:** COL 1:14, 21, 22 16;2:9 JN 1:3-4, 14; 14:1-3;5:22 HEB 1:2

ACTS 4:12 ISA 7:14 II COR 5:21 PHIL 2:10-11 I COR 15:3-4, 20

### FROM THIS WE LEARN: FUNDAMENTALIST BELIEVE:

1. Jesus Christ existed in the beginning and was God. Jn 1:14 Col 1:16
2. Jesus Christ created all things. Jn 1:3 Col 1:16 Heb 1:2
3. Jesus Christ is the giver of all life. Jn 1:4
4. Jesus Christ reveals the fullness of the Godhead. Col 1:15; 2:9
5. Jesus Christ only brings redemption & forgiveness of sins. Col 1:14 Acts 4:12
6. Jesus Christ was born of a virgin. Isa 7:14
7. Jesus Christ only can reconcile sinners to God. Col 1:21-22
8. Jesus Christ lived a sinless life. II Cor 5:21
9. All flesh should bow & accept Christ as Lord. Phil 2:10-11
10. Jesus Christ rose from the grave. I Cor 15:3-4, 20
11. Jesus Christ will come again & take all believers to Heaven. Jn 14:1-3
12. Jesus Christ will be the judge of the eternal destiny of all men. Jn 5:22

### C. BELIEVER'S BAPTISM?

**THE BIBLE SAYS:** ACTS 8:36-38 COL 2:12 ROM 6:4

### FROM THIS WE LEARN:

1. Baptism follows conversion. Acts 8:36-38
2. Baptism identifies believers with death, burial, & resurrection of Christ. Col 2:12, Rom 6:4

**D. THE LORD'S SUPPER?**

**THE BIBLE SAYS: I COR 11:24-25**

**FROM THIS WE LEARN:**

1. We are to observe the Lord's Supper to help us remember Christ's death & suffering for us.
2. We are to observe it often.
