THE BIBLE SAYS: LK 2:11 JN 4:25-26 LK 24:44
MATT 1:21 ACTS 4:12

1. Jesus of Nazareth is the promised Messiah. The names Christ and Messiah are identical. They mean "the Anointed One." Lk 2:11
2. Jesus Himself said He was the Messiah. Jn 4:25-26
3. Jesus said He was the One written of in the Law of Moses, the Prophets, & Psalms. Lk 24:44
4. Mary was instructed to call the Messiah "Jesus"- which means Savior. Matt 1:21
5. He is the only Savior of mankind. Acts 4:12
