1. We should pray always about every situation. Lk 18:1
2. We never cease praying—keep God on the line and do not quit your prayer life. I Thess 5:17
3. In the morning. Ps 5:3
4. At noon & in the evening. Ps 55:17
5. At least 3 times per day. Dan 6:10

1. You can pray everywhere. I Tim 2:8
2. Pray alone secretly. Matt 6:6

1. Pray for will of God, Second Coming, daily needs, forgiveness, guidance, and victory over temptation. Matt 6:9-13
2. Pray for sick. Jas 5:13-16
3. Pray for others, kings in authority, salvation of others. I Tim 2:1-4
4. Pray for longer life. Isa 38:1-5
5. Pray for personal safety & safety of others. Dan 6:18-23
6. Pray for wisdom & understanding. I Kings 3:5-9
7. Pray for your basic needs (clothing, shelter, food). Matt 6:25-34
8. Pray for prosperous journey. Rom 1:10
9. Pray for your enemies. Matt 5:38-45
10. Pray for those over you. I Tim 5:17

1. Our prayers are strengthened by our faith. Mark 11:24 James 1:6-7
2. Our prayers are strengthened by a forgiving heart. Mark 11:25 Rom 8:27
3. Our prayers are strengthened by praying according to God's will for our lives. Matt 26:39
4. Our prayers are strengthened by spiritual purity in your life. Iniquity means wickedness. Psa 66:18
5. Our prayers are strengthened by keeping His commandments. I Jn 3:22
6. Our prayers are strengthened by persevering with Christ. Abide means continue, persevere. Jn 15:7
7. Our prayers are strengthened by praying in Jesus name. He is our authority. Jn 16:24
8. Our prayers are strengthened by praying with right motives. James 6:3
9. Our prayers are strengthened by praying in the holy spirit. The Holy Spirit helps our prayers. Jude 20 Rom 8:15, 26
