WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT PROPHECY

INTRO: The word means to tell forth—not just foretelling—but revealing God's Word where it was before unknown. Revelation is revealing something beforehand.

I. WHAT IS BIBLE PROPHECY?

THE BIBLE SAYS: II PETER 1:18-21

FROM THIS WE LEARN:

- 1. Bible prophecies comes from Heaven. (18)
- 2. Bible prophecies are more sure than eye-witnesses. (19)
- 3. Bible prophecies are intended to be heeded—obeyed—observed—implemented. (19)
- 4. Bible prophecies are given to shed light. (19)
- 5. Bible prophecies are not the result of an individual—man is merely the conduit. (20)
- 6. Bible prophecies can not be conjured up by man. (21)
- 7. Bible prophecies are given to holy men.
- 8. Bible prophecies are given by the <u>Holy Spirit</u> to man. (21)

II. DO BIBLE PROPHECIES DIFFER FROM OTHER PROPHECIES?

FROM THIS WE LEARN:

- 1. Bible prophecies are detailed rather than general.
- A. Names are given. Cyrus is mentioned 150 years before the event.

 B. Locations are given—

 more than 600 years before.

 Isa 45:1-3

 Micah 5:2
- C. Minute details given: PSALM 22
- 1.Vs 1--words of Jesus.
- 2. Vs 8-- exactly what they said as He hung on the cross.
- 3. Vs 14-- bones out of joint.
- 4. Vs 16—pierced hands & feet.
- 5. Vs 18—gambled for his clothes.

ISAIAH 53

- 6. Vs2—when Messiah comes—not from the elite.
- 7. Vs 3—not popular or highly esteemed.
- 8. Vs 4-5-- substitute for us.
- 9. Vs 5—beaten & whipped.
- 10. Vs7-- would not open his mouth in defiance.
- 11. Vs 8—be killed.
- 12. Vs 9—buried with rich.
- 13. Vs 9—peaceful & pure man.
- 14. Vs 10—offered for sin offering.
- 15. Vs 11—bear iniquities of others.
- 16. Vs 12—numbered with transgressors.
- 17. Vs 12—interceded for others.
- 18. Luke 19:41-44--how Jerusalem would be destroyed.
- D. Dates are given:
- 1. Dan 9:24-27 written 600 BC—150 years before commandment to restore was given. Date to rebuild walls was firmly fixed.
- 2. When Christ entered Jerusalem on back of a colt, 445BC to 32 AD (march 14, 445 BC to April 6, 32 AD; Jews had 360 days in their years) is exactly 483 years.

- 3. Jeremiah tells us 70 years of captivity.
- E. Exact order is given:
- 1. In Dan 7, four great beasts refers to four nations.
- 2. Bible prophecy never fails. II Tim 3:16
- 3. Bible prophets agree with each other. Jude 14-15, Isa 13:3-5
- 4. Bible prophets lived holy lives in harmony with their message. II Peter 1:21
- 5. Did not prophecy for money.
