### John Wilbur Chapman 1859-1918

a young man by a godly mother & a spiritual father, Wilbur Chapman was led to Christ by his SS teacher. Mr. Chapman pastored four churches but devoted more than half of his ministry to evangelism. D.L. Moody counseled him to enter into evangelistic work full-time. He preached crusades in American, Canada, the British Isles, Japan, China, Australia, & many other countries.

He was also the first director of etc...). These teams held cruthe Winona Lake Bible Conference & contributed much to two other summer conferences - one at Montreal, NC, & one at Stony Brook, Long Island.

He had an unusual sense of humor, but he seldom joked; yet he trained an excitable, vehement seeker of souls to carry on after he was gone - a young baseball play- turned. Truly, he was a hero of er named Billy Sunday. No two men were ever more different in their methods; no two men ever agreed more completely on their message.

J. Wilbur Chapman was a product of, a preacher of, & a practitioner of personal work, or the "personal touch," as he often called it. He was a great one-onone soul-winner & counselor.

He was also a great song writer. His most loved song was "One Dav".

One day when heaven was filled with His praises, One day when sin was as black as could be. Jesus came forth to be born of a virgin, Dwelt amongst men, my example is He.

#### Chorus:

Living, He loved me; dving, He Greatly influenced for Christ as saved me: Buried, He carried my sins far away, Rising, He justified freely forever; One day He's coming, Oh, glorious day!

From 1904-1915. Chapman used a new method of urban mass evangelism. It was basically the use of a large staff of assistants with meetings held simultaneously in many sections of a city, stirring the whole area for God. In cities in the northeast (Pittsburgh, Boston, Philadelphia, Syracuse, sades all over the cities for weeks. He then took teams to Europe. Australia, the Philippines, .... Over one million people made public professions of faith.

With his health failing, Chapman continued to preach to large Bible conferences. He challenged them to be ready when Christ rethe faith!
