John Wilbur Chapman 1859-1918

Greatly influenced for Christ as a young man by a godly mother and a spiritual father, J. Wilbur Chapman was led to accept Christ by his Sunday school teacher and later found absolute assurance that he was a child of God through the personal counseling of D.L. Moody. Moody also personally encouraged Chapman, then a pastor, to enter wholly into evangelistic work.

Mr. Chapman held four pastorates but devoted more than half of his ministry to evangelism that carried him to major American cities, Canada, the British Isles, Japan, China, Australia, and many other countries. He was also the first director of the Winona Lake Bible Conference and contributed much to two other summer conferences – one at Montreal, NC, and one at Stony Brook, Long Island.

Though he had an unusual sense of humor, he seldom joked; yet he trained an excitable, vehement seeker of souls to carry on after he was gone – a young baseball player named Billy Sunday. No two men were

ever more different in their methods; no two men ever agreed more completely on their message.

J. Wilbur Chapman was a product of , a preacher of, and a practitioner of personal work, or the “personal touch,” as he often called it.

Truly, he was a hero of the faith!*****
